07.30 -08.00	:	Re-register and Meeting service at RINJANI BALLROOM LOBBY of Lombok Raya Hotel. Hand-in Consent Form.
08.00	:	Leaving for Banyumulek pottery village which is located about 10 km on the south of Mataram.
08.30 - 09.15	:	Arrive at Banyumulek, sight seeing around the pottery village to observe the making process of claypots and the living style of local villagers. The unique of Banyumulek is that the pots are still made by hand and simple tools, and mainly made by female potters. Such tradition has been maintained by local villagers for many generation. Banyumulek has been projected as a green tourism village by Lombok's Tourism Authority incorporating with GIZ (a German organization for less developed foreign countries development)
09.15	:	Heading down South to visit Tunak beach, which is located about 65 kms from Mataram. Photo stops can be made on the route when requested.
11.15 – 14.30	:	Arrive at Tunak Beach, a Lombok future ecotourism site.
		Tunak is located on the South Eastern part of Lombok. This untouched area is projected to be eco friendly tourism development where a number of projects such as healing forest and natural conservation, will be developed by consortium of Indonesia and South Korea government. A brief presentation of Tunak will be made by officials of Tunak Eco Project at the location. Lunch box will be served on the beach.
14.30	:	Trip continues to Madani, a preserved forest, located in the heart of Lombok. Driving to Madani is about 1,5 hours through countryside of Lombok.
16.00-18.30	:	Arrive at Madani, a brief tour around preserved forest. Presentation is made by owner of Madani project. Open mike session for comments on the visited sites. Dinner is served at Madani
18.30	:	Return to Hotel
20.00	:	Arrive at Lombok Raya Hotel
