## **WATERFALL (Benang Stokel Waterfall) ROUTE \***

Time		Route / Destination
07.30 -08.00	:	Re-register and Meeting service at RINJANI BALLROOM LOBBY of Lombok Raya Hotel. Hand-in <b>Consent Form</b>
08.00	:	Leaving for Banyumulek pottery village which is located about 10 km on the south of Mataram.
08.30 - 09.30	:	Arrive at Banyumulek, sight seeing around the pottery village to observe the making process of claypots and the living style of local villagers. The unique of Banyumulek is that the pots are still made by hand and simple tools, and mainly made by female potters. Such tradition has been maintained by local villagers for many generation. Banyumulek has been projected as a green tourism village by Lombok's Tourism Authority incorporating with GIZ (a German organization for less developed foreign countries development)
09.30	:	Heading up east to visit Benang Stokel Waterfall, which is located about 45 kms from Mataram. Photo stops can be made on the route when requested.
10.45 – 14.30	:	Arrive at Benang Stokel Village, soft trekking to see two waterfalls. First is a short walk to Benang Stokel Waterfall, and then from here is a 30 minute (1 hour return) walk through lush forest to see Benang Kelambu Waterfall. Along the way, various flora and faunas can be observed. Lunch box is served at Benang Stokel Waterfall. The soft trekking will be guided by local tour guides.
14.30	:	Trip continues to Madani, a preserved forest, located in the heart of Lombok.  Driving to Madani is about 1 hour through countryside of Lombok.
15.30-18.30	:	Arrive at Madani, a brief tour around preserved forest. Presentation is made by owner of Madani project.  Dinner is served at Madani
18.30	:	Return to Hotel
20.00	:	Arrive at Lombok Raya Hotel
